10 Week Game Award Details:

Rankings are based on a team's portfolio value. Rankings will no longer be based on the S&P 500.

Awards are given to the top 10 teams in each of the following divisions: Elementary, Middle School and High School. If a team consists of students from two or more grade levels, they must compete in the division appropriate for the highest grade level (i.e. a team consisting of both 5th and 6th grade students must compete in the middle school division, or a team of both 8th and 9th grade students must compete in the high school division).

Winning teams will receive:

- Recognition at a Stock Market Game Awards Banquet
- Certificates for each student, advisor and school
- Medal for each student
- T-shirts (to be distributed at awards banquet; will not be mailed if a team is unable to attend.)

New York City Trip - In addition to the above competitions, all students in the 10 week game compete in an all ages competition for a trip to New York City. One all expense paid trip to NYC will be awarded each semester. *The trip will be awarded to the top team in the ten week game based on portfolio value. The team will receive:*

- A trip to NYC for up to five team members and their advisor.
- A framed certificate signed by the Governor
- A traveling trophy - *The name of the winning school will be added to the list of past winners that are engraved on the trophy. The trophy may be displayed at the school but must be returned to Economics Wisconsin at the end of following SMG to be passed on to the next winning team*

Details of the SMG NYC Trip:

- The trip is sponsored by: Midwest Airlines, Robert W. Baird & Company, Inc and Economics Wisconsin.
- This award is limited to official participants in the Wisconsin Stock Market Game.
- This trip to New York City will depart from Mitchell International Airport-Milwaukee for the actual members of the winning team (not to exceed 5) plus its advisor.
- Economics Wisconsin reserves the right to review and approve the participation of the team's advisor or other chaperone.
- All participants are responsible for ground transportation to and from their homes to the airport and hotel costs if they choose to stay in Milwaukee prior to or after the trip.
- Scheduling of the specific dates for the trip is subject to seat availability on Midwest Airlines.
- Dates of the trip will be set by the sponsors. The winning team may not select their preferred dates of travel.
- Once ticketed, flight itinerary cannot be changed and tickets cannot be redeemed for cash.
- Hotel, meals and ground transportation in New York City will be provided by Robert W. Baird & Company, Inc.
- Liability insurance for the team and their advisor must be provided by the team's school district as Robert W. Baird & Company, Inc., Midwest Airlines and Economics Wisconsin cannot provide such coverage and will accept no responsibility therefore.

Enrichment Game Awards

Enrichment Games are offered three times each year. Teams participating in Enrichment Games are not eligible for recognition at SMG banquets or the NYC trip. First place teams in each grade level (elementary, middle school or high school division) will receive a certificates and t-shirts for each student and advisor.

School Year Challenge Awards

Students participating in the School Year Challenge must make at least one trade by October 30, 2009 to be eligible for prizes.

Teams compete in a statewide seven month simulation. First through third place teams in the state will receive a cash award, SMG T-shirts, recognition at the regional awards banquet, certificates for each student, advisor and school, in addition to a traveling trophy (The name of the winning school will be added to the list of past winners engraved on the trophy. The trophy may be displayed at the school but must be returned to Economics Wisconsin at the end of the year to be passed on to the next winning team the following year).

InvestWrite - A Nationwide Essay Contest

Students participating in the SMG are also eligible to enter the SMG Essay Contest, InvestWrite. InvestWrite is an innovative national writing competition, produced by The Stock Market Game program, that adds a critical thinking component to help reinforce concepts learned in the classroom.

- Every student currently registered in The Stock Market Game program with a valid team login ID and password is eligible.
- Your students participate by writing essays in their grade division: Elementary (4-5), Middle School (6-8), High School (9-12).
- Every assignment introduces or relates to investment principles linked to The Stock Market Game program. Each InvestWrite assignment ties to various lessons throughout the curriculum.
- Teachers can choose to assign the InvestWrite writing assignment as an in-class or homework assignment.
- Both teachers and students will have a chance to win gift certificates, laptop computers, and trips to New York or Disney World.
- Each participating student submission has a chance to be reviewed by the competition's first round judge...you, the teacher.
- Then, as the first round judge, you select the top five responses from each class or group of participants (based on the guidelines and directions).
- Then submit them electronically to the next round of evaluation at the national level on this web site.
